Each parent, as a natural guardian of his/her child, is presumed to have full authority regarding tuition, record release and enrollment, unless a court order restricts their authority. If custody is given by the courts to one parent, that parent has responsibility for communication and financial obligation. The Buckley Amendment requires that non-custodial parents be given information about the student's progress in school as well as unofficial copies of report cards unless there is a court order to the contrary.

Copies of NEW student's most recent report card, standardized test scores, baptismal certificate, and birth certificate must be included in order for the application to be complete. Michigan law requires that proof of up-to-date vaccinations be on file prior to the start of school. Students new to the school are accepted on probation to make sure that educational placement at MCES meets academic/behavioral needs.
