



## MONROE CATHOLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

### ***Transportation Options***

#### **Parent Drop-off / Parent Pick-up**

As part of a managed traffic flow system at each location, parents who choose to drop-off at more than one campus between St. Michael, St. John, and St. Mary will use either the “Drop-Off Lane” or the “Park and Walk.” These designated traffic patterns/areas will be communicated at a later date and will be managed by a *Traffic Coordinator* at each campus.

#### **Shuttle Bus Drop-off / Shuttle Bus Pick-up**

The free shuttle runs *to* the elementary campuses each morning. If your children will ride the morning shuttle bus from the St. Michael campus or the St. John campus, please plan to arrive to load the bus no later than 7:45 a.m.

The busses run to and from the elementary schools after school hours. The shuttles will reach the opposite campus by 3:00 p.m. Parents choosing to utilize the Shuttle Bus will pick-up their children at one campus at 3:00 p.m.

***After school, the oldest child will travel on the Shuttle Bus to the younger sibling’s elementary school. There will never be a need for kindergarten or first grade students to ride the Shuttle Bus in the afternoon.***

#### **Monroe Public School (MPS) Transportation**

Monroe Public Schools (MPS) offer bus transportation to students residing in the MPS district. MPS transportation will not differ in any way from previous years. Parents who choose to utilize the MPS Transportation can become familiar with the routes and routines of MPS by contacting the MPS transportation department.

In the morning MCES students (kindergarten – grade 8), riding the MPS bus to the Monroe Public Middle School will have the option of walking across the walk-way with a MCES faculty member to the St. John campus where the SMCC bus will then transport to St. Michael and/or St. Mary. This will allow for siblings to remain on the MPS bus together and not transfer alone at the Monroe Middle School. ***All MCES students will be gathered and walked by MCES faculty to either St. John or to the SMCC bus where they will be safely delivered to their school.***

MCES students, residing in the MPS district, riding the MPS bus in the afternoon will board the MPS bus at their school location at 2:30 p.m. as in past years.

#### **St. Mary Catholic Central (SMCC) Transportation**

SMCC provides bus transportation for MCES students (k – grade 8) residing in the following areas:

South Route:	Erie, LaSalle, Luna Pier, Lambertville, Temperance
Northeast Route:	Newport, Rockwood, Trenton
West Route:	Ida, Dundee
Northwest Route:	New Boston, Waltz, Flat Rock, Carleton

Students utilizing the SMCC bus will be transported directly to and from their school buildings.
